

**GRANT COUNTY  
LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE  
SPECIAL MEETING**

The Grant County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LECP) met June 6, 2017 at 6:00 pm at District Two (2) Office, 524 N Front St, Medford, OK. Notice of the Meeting, including Agenda, was posted at both entrances of the Grant County Courthouse, Medford, Oklahoma, June 5, 2017 at 4:30 pm in accordance with Title 25, O.S. § 301-314.

Jim Shepherd called the meeting to order at 6:03 pm. After roll call, a quorum was acknowledged. Present were Jeri Donaldson, Brandon Fetters, Cindy Pratt, Jim Shepherd, and guest, Traci Naile of OEM.

Pratt led the prayer.

Shepherd acknowledged the Agenda and Statement of Compliance with the Open Meeting Act.

Donaldson moved to approve the March 7, 2017 minutes as presented. Fetter seconded. *All • Aye.* Motion carried.

Traci Naile from the Office of Oklahoma Emergency Management was introduced. Ms. Naile explained part of her job is to help our local EM Personnel with program planning. Nail's main focus is on assisting counties with preparation and response. Nail assist with disaster support exercises and training.

The committee discussed the need to have a Full-Scale Emergency exercise for local EM personnel. Earth, Wind and Fire are good exercises to discuss as far as what can happen and how to react to certain types of emergency situations.

A Large-Scale exercise is schedule for October 31, 2017. The State and EOC are in partnership with the National Guard. The National Guard will have an exercise with equipment in the field and OEM will assist in this training.

Fetters reported a drone has been purchase but has not yet been delivered.

Fetters reported radios have been purchase from the donation earmarked for said purchase. Fetters will purchase a charging station for the EM pickup.

Shannon Currence of the Grant County Health Department will receive a Recognition Award on June 2, 2017 for her outstanding performance on the job.

The LEPC is considering hosting a Grain Bid Emergency class the summer of 2018. This training will be for all interest in attending but in particularly employees of surrounding Grain Elevators. Shepherd is setting up the TIM's training and a class for the Wakita Fire Department on Emergency Vehicle Operations.

With no further action to come before the Committee, Shepherd moved to adjourn at 7:05 pm. Donaldson seconded. All • Aye. Motion carried.
