

AND WHEREAS, said road posting shall be described as beginning at the intersection of Oklahoma State Highway 132 and Grant County EW 8 or Latimer Rd and continuing west on EW8 or Latimer Rd for four (4) miles to CR 750.

THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN, effective this date, the afore described road shall be restricted to NO THRU COMMERCIAL TRAFFIC.

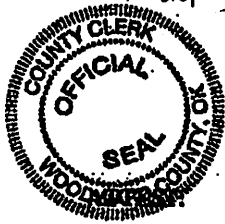

AND WHEREAS, said road posting shall be described as beginning at the intersection of Oklahoma State Highway 50 and Woodward County road *132 Grant County EW 8 or Latimer Rd* and continuing east on *west EW 8 Four (4)* EW 37 for *two (2)* miles, *Grant* thence south one (1) mile on Woodward County road *EW 8 or Latimer CR 750* NS 216 and EW 38.

THEREFORE BE IT KNOWN, effective this date, the afore described road shall be restricted to travel ~~ONLY~~ *No Thru Commercial Traffic* by vehicles weighing ~~no more than 25 tons gross weight~~.

WHEREAS, as it has become evident that a need exists to place a load limit of 25 tons on a certain Woodward County Road located in County Highway District #1.

AND WHEREAS, said road posting shall be described as beginning at the intersection of Oklahoma State Highway 50 and Woodward County road EW-37, and continuing east on EW-37 for two (2) miles, thence south one (1) mile on Woodward County road NS-216 to the intersection of County road NS-216 and EW-38.

THEREFORE BE IT KNOWN, effective this date, the afore described road shall be restricted to travel ONLY by vehicles weighing no more than 25 tons gross weight.
