Resolution No. 2020-87**

**WHEREAS**, We, the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, Oklahoma, on March 23, 2020 declared a disaster emergency situation due to Coronavirus Disease-2019 (COVID-19); and

**WHEREAS**, the Grant County Board of County Commissioner approved by Resolution 2020-80 to limit access to the District Shops to the public until 8:00 a.m., April 7, 2020. The Board of County Commissioner are extending the limitation to the District Shops to the public until 11:59 p.m. May 15, 2020; However, said period of time may be extended by the Board of County Commissioners for Grant County; and


