

RESOLUTION 2021-142

Amended Guidelines for COVID-19 for Grant County

These guidelines are subject to change as legislature changes. Changes will be submitted by the Board of County Commissioners as needed.

Guidelines for COVID exposure and/or symptoms:

1. The quarantine period is 7 days if a COVID test is taken on day 5-7 of quarantine and the result is negative. A copy of the test results or a signed doctor's release must be provided to the County.
2. The quarantine is 10 days, if no test is taken.
3. If a positive test occurs the employee must quarantine for 14 days.

Guidelines for COVID Paid Leave Entitlements with Grant County:

1. COVID FMLA expired 12-31-2020.
2. Grant County is adopting the policy of paying 10 days as a one-time entitlement for 2021.
 - a. Total amount of days paid for COVID leave is 10 days for 2021.
 - b. If the employee chooses to use their COVID paid for leave for a household member, paid leave for COVID pay up to 10 days total for 2021.

(For example: employee quarantines for 6 days, then returns to work with negative test result, the employee will have 4 days of COVID paid leave remaining for use, if another occurrence arises.)


These guidelines are at the disclosure of that employee's supervisor/elected official and must be authorized by their supervisor/elected official.


